Funding - Established Allied Membership Program; generated non-dues income with CEU programs.

Facilities - Established and increased the visibility of AIA Indiana Bookstore (50 S. Meridian St., downtown Indianapolis); AIA Indiana and Indianapolis chapter events and meetings held in bookstore and Ball State Indianapolis Center classrooms; office of the executive director established at 50 S. Meridian St., Suite 302.

Staffing - Established operational policies and procedures and employee handbook.

Confidence Building - Minimum requirements and activities for AIA Chapter Charters are being met via shared services arrangement; the executive director assists all Indiana chapters.

Public Posture - Executive Director meeting regularly with QBS, ACEC, Ball St. CAP, MICSS, DBIA, ICA, ISA, IEDC, Building Excellence, legislators, etc.; events are being held in the bookstore (book signing featuring Witold Rybczynski, AIA Indianapolis Chapter event reception featuring former Honolulu Mayor Jeremy Harris).

Communication - New website established and updated daily; weekly "AIA Indiana Sketches ENews" updates emailed to all members and friends; executive director has attended at least one chapter meeting in all Indiana chapters and visited with firms throughout the state.

Legislative - Implemented AIA Indiana Days at the Statehouse; pushed proactive sustainable design legislation and fought interior design registration legislation, which was eventually vetoed; weekly "AIA Indiana Legislative ENewsletter" emailed to all members and friends and posted on website.

Education - Successful "Designing with the Codes" Seminar, which offered 8 HSW.

Membership - Created and implemented Allied Memberships; increased member retention rate.

Shared Services - Weekly "AIA Indiana Sketches ENews" updates feature updated information and news from all chapters; website hosts chapter specific web pages; executive director assists each chapter with events and other action items.

Community Services - "Indiana's Favorite Architecture" project launched; the AIA150/CIAA Columbus Indiana Symposium, sponsored by the Columbus Indiana Architectural Archives, was integrated with the 2007 AIA Indiana/AIA Kentucky Convention.

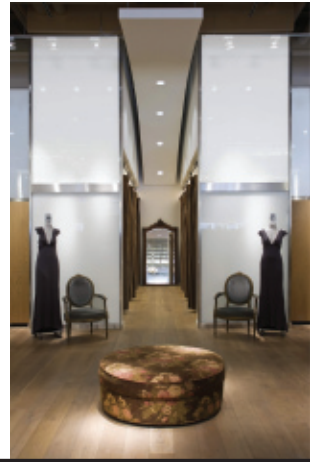

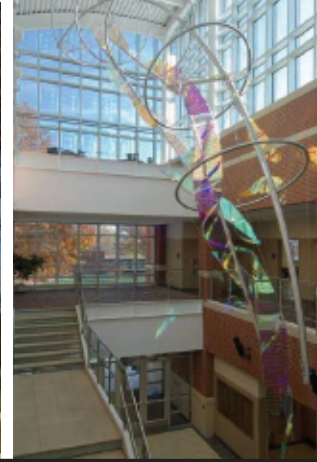
