2008 ACHIEVEMENTS

Legislative - Passed sustainable design study committee legislation; helped craft the governor's Energy Efficient State Building Initiative, mandating all new state buildings be designed, constructed and operated for maximum energy efficiency; eliminated negative stock school plan legislative proposals and succeeded in reaching a positive compromise; successfully sustained the governor's veto of interior design registration legislation; increased AIA Indiana member presence at the Statehouse via numerous "AIA Indiana Days at the Statehouse."

Membership - Increased Hoosier AIA membership by three percent; maintained Hoosier AIA member retention rate (93%); increased number of AIA Indiana Allied Members (15).

Education - Increased the number of education programs; "Designing with the Codes" Seminar conducted in each Hoosier AIA chapter; "Design-Build for the Architects: Return of the Master Builder" Seminar.

Confidence Building - Executive Director provided assistance to all Hoosier AIA chapters and attended many of their chapter meetings; increased number of member firm visits in each chapter by the executive director; updated strategic plan.

Funding - Increased non-dues revenue via increased number of allied members and continuing education programs.

Communication - Published expanded and improved 2008 AIA Indiana Directory; maintained and improved member communications and website; increased promotion and information regarding FAIA; increased media visibility regarding legislative issues (Op-Eds published in multiple Indiana newspapers regarding sustainable design and stock school plans); improved promotion of AIA Indiana Design Awards winners.
